The Regatta will be governed by the rules of racing as defined in the
Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2012)

Eligible participants include those that own or are allowed to operate a sailboat while enjoying the company of others. On the morning of July 23rd,

the BCYC will provide each participant with an individual start time. Racers will start at the designated start at the designated time and do their best not to get passed. Before finishing in East Jordan via the South arm of Lake Charlevoix, participants shall wave, hoot, and cheer while passing the Ironton Ferry while under control. (Engines may be used at the discretion of the skipper until safely past the Ferry)

Once competitors arrive at the East Jordan Marina (536-2166), they shall graciously welcome other competitors as they finish... leaving the last boat with the loudest and most gracious welcome (each boat shall make their own docking arrangements with the EJ Marina)

The Cost to enter this extremely exciting Australian pursuit race is \$15... However, an additional fee of \$10 will bump the entry fee to \$25 for those that insist on procrastinating (entries not postmarked by July 15th will be considered procrastinated entries)

(Checks shall be made to the BCYC with Iron Works in the memo and mailed as directed by the entry form)

Check-in and procrastinator registration will begin at 9am at the Boyne City Marina Lighthouse, located in Boyne City. The Skipper's meeting will begin at 10am at which time, Start times will be announced. The first start will be @ 12pm, GPS time. At 16:00 all competitors not finished, will start their engines and race via 'iron genny' to the finish.

After all the gratuitous celebrating and all boats have finished, competitors will meet at Murray's Pub and Grill at which time the award ceremony will commence. Awards will be given to the top 3 boats in each fleet and a special award for the boats that were passed the most. The First place winner from each fleet will have their name placed on the East Jordan Iron Works man-hole cover located at the BRI, Boyne City

For those competitors choosing to stay overnight in EJ, the BCYC will be holding their annual Mimosa Pancake Breakfast at 9am or so... or whenever the cooks decide it's time for more fun!
